

Dear Alliance Family. Thank you for your trust and support to this servant of yours.

For me to present the year report is not just about numbers. To me it is about people who have been safe, baptized, healed, deliverance of demons and people get reconcile with God. Putting all this together I confirm that it is all about Jesus and Jesus needs all of us to fulfil his Great Commission.

I reached out the National office to request some data of the Central Pacific District from the last 20 Years. I did it with the intention to learn from the pass and to ask for guidance for the future.

The national office sent me a report that represent our district very well.

Before I share the data, I would like to clarify some language that we use in church planting for you to have more understanding about the data.

Let me remind you about the stages that a church goes through in the church planting journey.

- 1. Planning Stage—New Projects
  - a. A core team begins to be developed
  - b. Demographic data is gathered to be used in strategic community engagement and outreach
  - c. The church planting pastor is identified and passes the assessment processes.
  - d. The assessment and training process for the church plant are completed.

## 2. Emerging Stage

- a. A minimum of 10 adults is a part of the Church Planting Team.
- b. They start a regular service of at least once a week.
- c. The Church Planting Pastor has passed the accreditation process.
- d. This is the timeframe for Dexcom to approve the church and for the church to be added in the Church Ministry Software (CMS) with the Alliance. CMS is the management software that keeps track of all pastoral and church data for the Alliance.
- e. Bank account and EIN number is added at this time.

- f. Application for C&MA church planting grant
- 3. Developing Stage
  - a. Minimum of 20 adults are a part of the church
  - b. Regular practicing of the ordinances
  - c. Advisory team is created
  - d. Local church bylaws are developed
- 4. Accredited Stage
  - a. A church can purchase property beginning at this stage
  - b. A Governing Authority is developed
  - c. Minimum of 20 adults is needed to be accredited
  - d. Articles of Incorporation completed
  - e. Membership Class takes place and original members are approved

Now I would like to share some information about our CPD churches.

In 2005 the CPD had a total 51 Accredited churches no new projects and no new church plant.

In 2015 the CPD had a total of 67 Accredited churches, and 2 new churches were planted.

In 2024 the data for the CPD shows.

CPD has a total of 111 Churches.

- 70 Accredited Churches
- 4 Affiliate Churches
- 4 Redeveloping Churches
- 13 Developing Churches
- 20 Plant churches (16 Emerging and 4 Planning). These are already in the CMS.

In addition to this report, I'm presenting you a list of new potential church plants for this year of 2025, that I am already working on. We are currently working on a total of 17 new potential churches and four of them had already been launched.

January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025, La Voz de Dios in Truckee, CA

February 9<sup>th</sup> ,2025. Cristo es la Puerta #2 in American Canyon

February 23, 2025. Nueva Vida in San Jose, CA

April 6th, 2025 Cristo es la Puerta #3 in Fairfield, CA

As today 2025 the CPD has

- \* 70 Accredited Churches
- \* 4 Affiliate Churches
- \* 4 Redeveloping Churches
- \* 14 Developing Churches
- \* 24 Plant Churches (Emerging)

Total of Churches in the SMS 116

\* 13 Planning-New projects If we launch these new projects we will have 129 Churches in our district. (remember is not about number it is All About JESUS) Rob's heart to plant 50 new churches in 5 years. (since 2022)

2023 total of 6 Churches were planted

2024 total of 8 churches were plant

2025 we had plant 4 churches and 13 new projects are in process.
